- tailored capacity building for law and policy makers to implement international commitments and achieve policy goals, based on FAO's unique experience in the agriculture sectors.






FAO projects

Our innovative research and global tool kit

Our unique study on the intersection between climate and agriculture goals in national legislation provides lessons learnt and recommendations on:

- legal obligations and principles from the Paris
 Agreement applicable to implementation of NDCs
- enabling conditions of current legislative frameworks for climate change and agriculture sectors
- formulation of required legislation for addressing climate goals in agriculture sector
- promoting integration of policy issues across food and agriculture sectors
- tailoring legal frameworks to circumstances, challenges and needs.

(UN Environment, the UN Framework
Convention on Climate Change
[UNFCCC] Secretariat and the
Commonwealth Secretariat), we are
developing an online Law and Climate
Change Toolkit for countries to be able to:

- assess their national legislation in relation to their climate goals and NDCs
- identify areas for improving their national laws with regards to implementation of their NDCs
- have access to examples of laws from other countries.
