## **MAJOR FINDINGS**

The 'traditional economy' lalso known as subsistence economy, custo economy is an alternative to unsustainable orthodox macro-econom strategies for growth and development.

The traditional economy encourages sustainable economic activity at the individual and household level while operating within reciprocal networks of exchange and obligation at the community level.

The primary contact point for ASRL interdisciplinary research is at the community level to ensure research is culturally sensitive and safeguards culturally based social protection systems.
