The ASEAN Climate Resilience Network (ASEAN-CRN)

Name: The ASEAN Climate Resilience Network in the Promotion of Climate Smart Agricultural Practices.

Covered region / countries: 10 Member States of the Association of Southeast Asian Nation (ASEAN) namely Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam.

Status: Initiated since 2013, recognized and endorsed by the ASEAN Ministers of Agriculture and Forestry (AMAF).

Context: The ASEAN Climate Resilience Network (ASEAN-CRN) is a platform for regional exchange, particularly for sharing information, experiences, and expertise on climate smart agriculture (CSA), which is supported by the ASEAN German-Programme on Response to Climate Change in Agriculture and Forestry (GAP-CC) through the Forestry and Climate Change (FOR-CC) module.

Objective of the ASEAN-CRN: The ASEAN-CRN is established to promote the adaptive capacity of ASEAN Member States (AMS) to climate change and enhance the resilience of major crops for food security. Likewise, the ASEAN CRN supports the process of scaling up of CSA practices amongst AMS through regional cooperation.

Members: ASEAN Member States, Donor partners, International Organizations, Private sectors, Academia, other related ASEAN Bodies such as ASEAN Sectoral Working Group on Crops (ASWGC), ASWGCC (ASEAN Sectoral Working Group on Climate Change)

Governance: ASEAN – CRN links with policy makers to scientific institutions, universities, national research institutions in agriculture, and international organizations. It serves as a dialogue platform in the region that promotes climate resilience through exchange of information, expertise, and experiences on climate smart agriculture (CSA).

Timeline / Key events: Initiated since 2013, series of climate resilience workshops conducted, ASEAN CRN Annual Planning Meeting, participation to various international events on climate change adaptation i.e. APAN, Global CSA Conference (Montpellier France), Global Landscape Forum (Paris, France), UNFCCC SBSTA Workshop (Bonn, Germany), etc.
