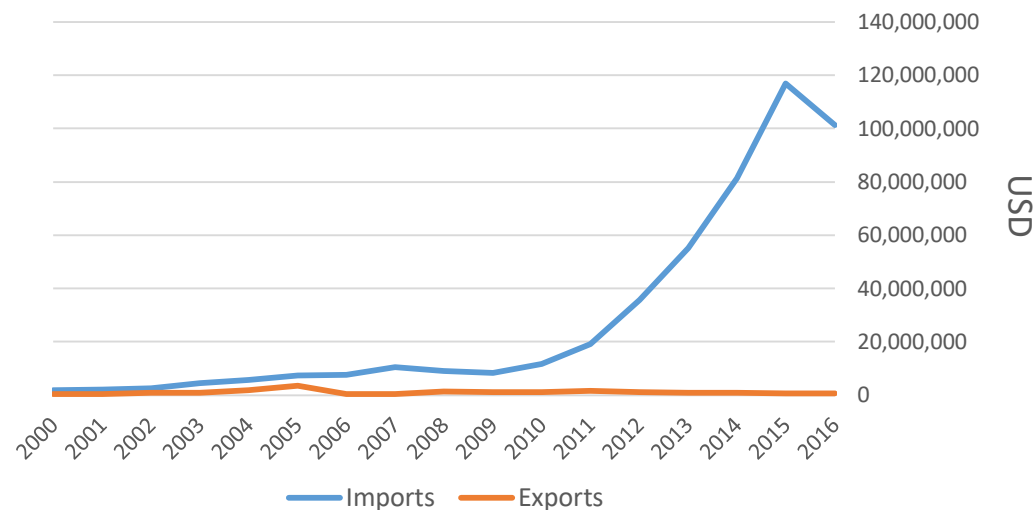

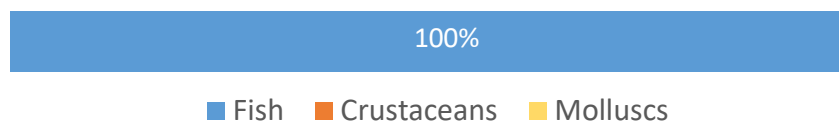

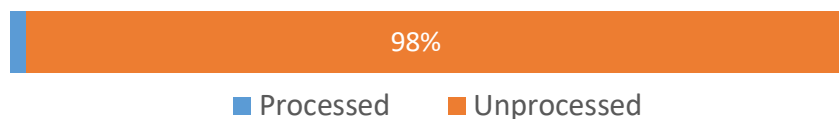

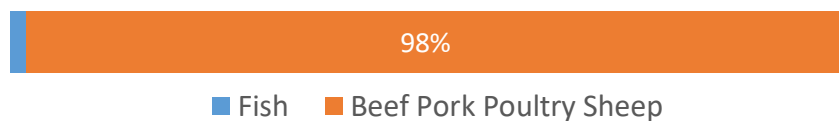
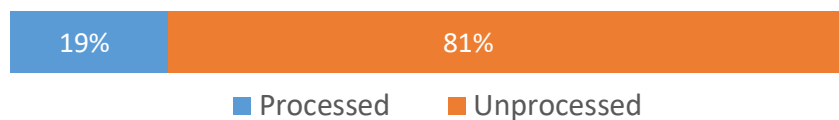
### Production by volume

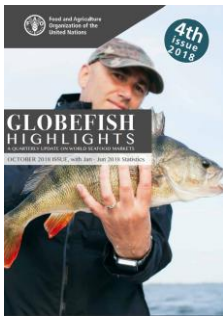
# A GLOBEFISH Product
