Management Response

Introduction

The final evaluation of the project "Integrated management of marine and coastal spaces of high value for biodiversity in continental Ecuador" aims to describe the impacts of the project, the sustainability of the results and the degree of achievement of the long-term results. Likewise, it indicates the future actions necessary to ensure the sustainability of the project results, expand the impact in successive phases, integrate and expand its products and practices, and disseminate the information obtained among the authorities and institutions with competencies in integrated coastal management, and conservation and sustainable use of marine and coastal biodiversity, to ensure the continuity of the processes initiated by this project.

Since 2006, FAO's evaluation policy states that all FAO evaluations must receive a management response and a follow-up report. The standardized and guaranteed quality of the Organization's responses and follow-up reports on evaluations improves the transparency of the evaluation process and provides lessons on the effectiveness and compliance of the corporate evaluation policy.
