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#### Accessible

Train large number of participants across areas/time zones Materials remain accessible online Increase access to international and regional expertise

#### Adaptable

Translate materials Adapt content to new contexts/audiences Convert training styles in response to travel restrictions

#### Affordable

Reduce need to travel Lower carbon footprint Repurpose existing courses





A regionally-based **virtual learning hub** supporting development and delivery of online courses, workshops and resources to build capacity through:

- assessing the specific needs of the region
- providing tailored online courses
- supporting virtual networking
- promoting national cascade of training resources
- encouraging continuing professional development.


**Initial focus:** training **animal health practitioners** to improve capacity for management of priority diseases and health threats.

**Future scope:** include training materials across a range of disciplines and providers, tailored to the needs of the region.






#### A Collaborative Initiative




- Seed funding and mentoring from EuFMD
- Hosted and co-funded by FAO RAP
- Objective to become self-sustaining





- Aligned with regional training needs assessment (TNA)
- Interactive, tailored, <u>tutored</u> courses
- Develop strong **partnerships** with regional training providers
- **Quality management system** maintained throughout the training lifecycle





#### The Virtual Possibilities

#### **Self-directed courses**

- Interactive online modules, quizzes, assessments
- Open access to reach wider audience
- Self-paced

#### **Tutored virtual courses**

- Large audiences (up to 500 trainees)
- 10 15 hours over 4 weeks
- Interactive online modules, quizzes, assessments, live webinars, discussion forum

#### In-depth virtual courses

- Intensive training for small groups
- 15 24 hours over 4 6 weeks
- Interactive online modules, quizzes, assessments, live webinars, discussion forum

#### Virtual workshops

Facilitated sessions, presentations, breakout groups

#### **Regional meetings**

Support for regional networks and partners

#### **Blended learning**

Tailored combinations of virtual and face-to-face training

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# What we need to keep in mind when **designing a virtual course**?

- Develop a combination of training methods: offer pre-study and further reading materials, self-assessment and optional sessions
- Choose appropriate modalities: Be realistic when planning to achieve a beautiful goal
- Provide precise instructions
- Encourage peer support and sharing through online communication tools
