# Funding requests

# During this period, the BOA considered the following requests:

- The Fire Management Working Group requested USD 10,000, mostly for travel, for the development of workshops aimed at developing the North America wild land work fire science blueprint.
- Funding provided by FAO for the organization of a Gypsy Moth Prevention and Early Detection Knowledge Transfer Workshop, which had to be rescheduled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.




## Combating illegal logging
