Infrastructure and Demography - Agriculture Population

### **Proportion of Households for Which Agriculture is the Primary Activity**

This map shows the proportion of households for which agriculture is the primary source of income. For most communes this ranges between 75% and 95% of households. The pattern is in stark contrast to that shown by the map of agricultural population density ([Map 2.2.1](#)). The highest dependence on agriculture for livelihoods is in the overwhelmingly agricultural communes of the northern mountainous and Central Highland regions (dark green). A striking characteristic shown by this map is the lower dependence on agriculture for livelihoods in the vicinity of the major urban centres, especially Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City, and in the coastal areas, where fisheries also play important livelihoods roles.
