Agriculture, Forestry and Aquaculture – Forestry

### **Proportion of Forested Land Allocated to Households for Long-Term Use**

Forested land allocated to households, as defined in the 2001 census, includes that allocated for long-term use, contracted land, land purchased at auction, land that has been acquired through rights of use transfer, rented land, inherited land and mortgaged land. This includes land under the process of allocation to households for long-term use, but excludes land allocated and not used by the allocated households, but rented out, leased or transferred.

The map reveals communes with the highest proportions of forestry land allocated to households (coloured green) to be concentrated in the Northwest mountainous region, the northern part of the North Central Coast, and parts of the Southeast and the Mekong River Delta. In the Central Highlands and mountainous areas of the Northwest, the percentage of forestry land allocated to households remains low because the majority of these lands are managed by State Forest Enterprises (SFEs) and State Agricultural Enterprises (SAEs).
