The following joint or cross-border surveys (CBS) were carried out in 2012 in the framework of the “Five-year Programme to improve national and regional locust management in Caucasus and Central Asia”, against USAID funding:

- Kyrgyzstan & Uzbekistan, April 2012
- Georgia, Azerbaijan & Armenia, April 2012
- Afghanistan & Tajikistan, June 2012.
- Turkmenistan & Uzbekistan, July 2012.

Presentation on this activity will be made by the concerned countries during the workshop.

The proposed template for countries’ presentations is as follows:

- I. General information
 - Background of CBS: which is the nature of the locust issue between the concerned countries?
 - Purpose of CBS: which locust species was/were monitored? Which locust developmental stage was surveyed?
 - Surveyed regions (please include maps)
 - Participants (number, profile, age)
 - Equipment and material used (Vehicles, GPS, Map, Survey Standard form...)
 - Funding aspects (funding, including national contributions if any; use of funds, etc.)
- II. Main results and findings (include pictures)
- III. Recommendations for locust control services in both countries based on the survey results
- IV. Issues faced in conducting the CBS, lessons learned and recommendations for future CBS between these countries
