NOTE SUR LES OPÉRATIONS DE LUTTE CONTRE LE CRIQUET PÉLERIN

1. Funding and state of execution of the ECLC programme

One inter-regional Desert Locust control project, funded by FAO's Technical Cooperation Programme (TCP), provided assistance to Yemen. At the completion of the project, on 30 November 2005, an assistance worth US\$141 383 had been provided to this country.

2. Assistance provided by FAO in 2004 and 2005

- **Technical assistance:** In-service training and local temporary assistance were provided for an amount of US\$14 000.
- **Pesticides:** 15 000 litres of the pesticide Fenitrothion 450 for an amount of US\$93 568 were delivered to Yemen in September 2004.
- **Equipment:** Positioning and communication equipment (10 GPS and 2 mobile radios, respectively) were provided for an amount of US\$14 415, and fuel, tyres, vehicle spare parts, office stationery and other field supplies were provided for US\$16 400.
- **Training:** Yemen participated in a regional workshop on RAMSES, eLocust and satellite imagery interpretation held in March 2006 in Cairo.
