## **BACKGROUND**

- 1. The 45<sup>th</sup> Session of the Committee on Food Hygiene (CCCFH) agreed to advance the proposed Draft Guidelines for the Control of *Trichinella* spp. in Meat of Suidae to the 46<sup>th</sup> Session of the Commission for adoption at Step 5/8 (REP14/FH, para. 64 and Appendix III).
- 2. The 36<sup>th</sup> Session of the Commission adopted the proposed draft Guidelines at Step 5 only with the understanding that further consideration of the Guidelines in CCFH would be focused on sections 7.3 and 9 (REP14/CAC, para. 51-52, Appendix IV).
