## **CropLife International Perspectives on Proposed Changes to IESTI Equations**

CropLife International conducted an analysis of potential changes of the IESTI equations, as proposed in the conclusion of a workshop conducted by several regulatory authorities in Sep 2015..

On Monday 25 April during after plenary at 17.15 to 18:15, CropLife will present a number of case studies to illustrate our main concerns: 1.) Potential loss of a significant number of MRLs 2.) Overly conservative exposure assessment 3.) Risk communication challenges.

As the proposed revision of the IESTI equations are not related to a current lack of consumer protection, CropLife advocates for an elaborated approach, considering the full impact of all changes on trade and on risk communication. For more details see CRD15.
