#### **Recommendation 35:**

#### Comments:

The Republic of Korea supports the proposal that the definition of (name of product) for young children be edited:

[Name of product] for young children means a product specially [formulated and] manufactured for use as a liquid part of the [progressively] [diversified] diet of young children [in order to contribute to the nutritional needs of young children] [when nutrient intakes may not be adequate to meet nutritional requirements].

#### Rationale:

The use of the proposed "formulated" in the definition is not consistent with the product definition proposals for follow-up formula for older infants and the product definition in the Infant Formula Standard.

# **Recommendation 37:**

## Comments:

The Republic of Korea supports the name **Formulated drink for young children** for product for the 12 – 36 months age group.

### Comments:

The Republic of Korea suggests that more scientific evidence would be needed for "free" of Trans Fatty Acids(TFAs) claim.

#### Rationale:

It is limited evidence because portion of foods typically consumed per day are based on only Canadian Community Health Survey.
