

1. The 46th Session of the Committee (CCFL46) agreed that the paper on future work and emerging issues would be updated by New Zealand¹.

2. To assist the development of the paper on future work and emerging issues, CCFL46 agreed to request members and observers to provide information on issues for inclusion in the paper.

In making submissions, the members are requested to indicate whether the new work / emerging issue, if taken up as new work proposal, in accordance with the Criteria for the Establishment of Work Priorities (see Codex Procedural Manual), would likely lead to preparation of a new standard/guideline or revision of an existing standard/guideline.
