Final Adoption (At Steps 8, 5/8 and 5A)

Part 1 – Standards and related texts submitted for adoption

1. Standard for Aubergines (Draft)

Indonesia has no objection with the adoption of draft standard for Aubergines at step 8. However, Indonesia concerns on the differences between “Extra Class” and “Class I” on the section of Quality Tolerance. Before adoption at Step 8, Indonesia proposes to revise the text for “Extra Class” to be as follow: “Five per cent by number or weight, of aubergines not satisfying the requirements of the Class but meeting those of Class I is allowed. Included therein, is 4 0.5% tolerance for decay, soft rot and/or internal breakdown.
