# WHO's work on monitoring policies and actions to promote healthy diets and nutrition

## 1993-2001: Monitoring of 1992 ICN commitments



- Regular regional review meetings
- WHO Global Database on National Nutrition Policies and Programmes

## 2009-2010: 1<sup>st</sup> Global Nutrition Policy Review

- Survey; 123 country responses
- Policies, actions, capacities and coordination
- WHO Global database on the Implementation of Nutrition Action (GINA)

## 2016-2017: 2<sup>nd</sup> Global Nutrition Policy Review

- Survey; 173 country responses (89%)
- Policies, actions, capacities and coordination
- GINA, Global Nutrition Monitoring Framework, ICN2 reporting and Decade of Action baseline








# Dietary intake policy goals in 163 countries




# Actions to promote and protect healthy diets in 158 countries




# Types of nutrition labelling in 121 countries




# Nutrient declaration in 74 countries




# Nutrients mandatory to declare in 66 countries




# Types of Front-of-Pack labelling in 37 countries




# Nutrients included in FOP systems in 37 countries




# Criteria used to determine eligibility of health and nutrition claims in 69 countries
