1. VENUE

The 49th Session of Codex Committee on Pesticide Residues will be held in **Kunlun Function Hall**(昆仑 堂), the second floor of the **Hotel Kunlun** (昆仑饭店), **No. 2 Xin Yuan Nan Lu, Chaoyang District, Beijing, 100004**, **P.R. 


