## ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

- **Item 1** Adoption of the agenda (Doc. Ref. CX/ASIA 10/17/1): In accordance with Rule VII.2 of the Rules of Procedure, the first item on the Provisional Agenda shall be the adoption of the Agenda.
- Item 2 Matters arising from the Codex Alimentarius Commission and other Codex committees and task forces (Doc. Ref. CX/ASIA 10/17/2): This item includes matters related to the region arising from recent sessions of the Commission and other Codex committees and task forces.
- Item 3 Consideration of draft standards at Step 7
- **Item 3(a) Draft regional standard for sago flour (N06-2007)** (Doc. Ref. ALINORM 09/32/15, Appendix V)): The 32<sup>nd</sup> Session of the Commission adopted the proposed draft standard for sago flour at Step 5 and advanced it to Step 6 for comments. Document CX/ASIA 10/17/3 compiles comments at Step 6 submitted in response to CL 2009/25-ASIA.
- Item 4 Consideration of proposed draft standards at Step 4
- Item 4(a) Proposed draft standard for non-fermented soybean products (N06-2005) (Doc. Ref. CX/ASIA 10/17/4): The 16<sup>th</sup> CCASIA agreed to return the proposed draft Standard to Step 2 for redrafting by an electronic working group, on the basis of the written comments, for circulation for comments at Step 3 and further consideration at its 17<sup>th</sup> Session. Comments at Step 3 on the revised proposed draft standard are compiled in document CX/ASIA 10/17/6-Add.1.
- **Item 4(b) Proposed draft regional standard for chili sauce (N05-2007)** (Doc. Ref. CX/ASIA 10/17/5): The 16<sup>th</sup> CCASIA agreed to return the proposed draft regional standard to Step 2 for redrafting by an electronic working group, on the basis of the written comments and its discussion, for circulation for comments at Step 3 and further consideration at its 17<sup>th</sup> Session. Comments at Step 3 on the proposed draft standard are compiled in document CX/ASIA 10/17/5-Add.1
- Item 5 Status of implementation of the Strategic plan for the Coordinating Committee for CCASIA (Doc. Ref. CX/ASIA 10/17/6): The 16<sup>th</sup> CCASIA agreed to adopt the Strategic plan for CCASIA 2009-2014 and to request the Coordinator to monitor the implementation of the Strategic Plan and to present a report on the status of implementation at the 17<sup>th</sup> Session of the CCASIA.
- **Item 6 Issues relevant to the region** (Doc. Ref. CX/ASIA 10/17/7): In order to facilitate the development of regional positions, the 16<sup>th</sup> CCASIA agreed to add to its agenda, as a standing agenda item, a paper the discussion of "Issues relevant to the region" and to request the Coordinator for the region to prepare a paper on this subject for consideration at its next session (see ALINORM 09/32/15, para. 18).
- Item 7 National food control systems and consumer participation in food standard setting (Doc. Ref. CX/ASIA 10/17/8): The Committee will discuss information submitted in response to CL 2010/17-ASIA, which include a template, developed by an electronic working group (see ALINORM 09/32/15, para. 99) which would facilitate the analysis of the information on food control systems and link it to the activities of the Strategic Plan for CCASIA.
- **Item 8 Discussion paper on tempe and tempe products** (Doc. Ref. CX/ASIA 10/17/9): The 16<sup>th</sup>CCASIA agreed to request Indonesia to prepare a comprehensive discussion paper on tempe and tempe products to justify the need for new work and including a detailed project document, for consideration at its next session (ALINORM 09/32/15 para. 117).
