INFORMATION NOTE

Proposed Draft Maximum Levels for Fumonisin in Maize and Maize-Products and Associated Sampling Plans (held at Step 4) (N10-2009). The 4th session of the Committee agreed to retain the proposed draft MLs for fumonisins in maize and maize-products at Step 4 until further advice was provided by JECFA (ALINORM 10/33/41, para. 95). Fumonisin is scheduled for discussion by JECFA in June 2011.
