### CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSED DRAFT STANDARDS AND RELATED TEXTS AT STEP 5

#### Codex Committee on Soups and Broths

1. The Codex Committee on Soups and Broths was adjourned *sine die* by the 12th Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission (1978). The 21st Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission (1995) entrusted the revision of the Revised Codex Standard for Bouillons and Consommés (CODEX STAN 117-1981, Rev.1-1995) to this Committee. In order to carry out this task, it has been working by correspondence on the revision of the *Proposed Draft Revised Codex Standard for Bouillons and Consommés*.

2. The Executive Committee is invited to consider advancing the *Proposed Draft Revised Codex Standard for Bouillons and Consommés* as proposed in Appendix I to ALINORM 01/29 to Step 6.

#### Codex Committee on Vegetable Proteins

3. The Codex Committee on Vegetable Proteins was adjourned *sine die* by the 18<sup>th</sup> Session of the Commission (1989). The 23<sup>rd</sup> Session of the Commission (1999) noted that the Committee had been requested to undertake a revision of the Codex Standard for Wheat Gluten (CODEX STAN 163-1987). The revision has been carried out by correspondence through the Secretariat of the Committee (Canada). It is proposed to rename the Standard as *Proposed Draft Revised Codex Standard for Wheat Protein Products*.

4. The Executive Committee is invited to consider advancing *Proposed Draft Revised Codex Standard for Wheat Protein Products* as proposed in Appendix I to ALINORM 01/37 to Step 6.
