4. DOCUMENTS

5. TRANSPORT FROM THE AIRPORT

Nanjing Airport is located 45km southwest to **Fairmont Nanjing Hotel** within one hour by taxi. Participants should make their own transport arrangements from the airport to the hotel.

6. VISA ARRANGEMENTS

Delegates should check with their local Chinese Embassy or Consulate as to whether they need a visa to enter China. Visa application forms, as well as the information requirement, are available from the following website http://english.gov.cn/2005-08/29/content_27141.htm.

The delegates from the countries that haven't established diplomatic relationship with China, could acquire the visa from the adjacent country which has established diplomatic relationship with China.

7. BANKS, ATMS AND EXCHANGE

The legal currency in China is the RMB (yuan). Exchange rate is variable but at the time of writing (December 2013) [US\$1 = 6.10yuan, and 1 Euro = 8.39yuan].

Currency can be exchanged at the airport, in hotels and in selected banks. Automatic teller machines may be found in the airport terminals, most hotels and some banks. Major credit cards are accepted in hotels and large shopping centres.

8. WEATHER CONDITIONS

The weather of Nanjing in May is typically sunny and warm with light winds. Average temperatures range from 20°C-27°C. Delegates are advised to dress accordingly.

9. LUNCH AND DINING ARRANGEMENTS

Delegates should make their own arrangements for lunch and dinner. There is a variety of facilities available inside the Nanjing Fairmont Hotel (buffet lunch, restaurants, etc) and there are restaurants and fast-food shops near the Hotel.

10. ELECTRICITY

The voltage in Nanjing is 220 volts 50 Hz AC.

11. MOBILE PHONES

GSM phone that operate on 900/1800 MHz, which generally excludes North American ones are used in China. Chinese SIM cards which give a local cell phone number for cheaper local calls and recharging cards can be purchased anonymously in bookstalls, telephone and computer stores.

12. SMOKING

Smoking is not allowed in the public. Usually, there are smoking and non-smoking areas in hotels. The meeting venue is within the non-smoking areas.

13. BUSINESS AND SHOPPING HOURS

Offices and businesses are generally open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday. Shops are generally open from 9:30 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily.
