BACKGROUND

CCFL39 advanced the Proposed Draft Definition of Nutrient Reference Values (for Inclusion in the Guidelines on Nutrition Labelling (CAC/GL 2-1985)) to step 5.

CAC34 (July 2011) adopted the proposed draft definition at Step 5 and advanced it to Step 6. It will be considered at Step 7 by CCFL40 to be held in Ottawa, Canada from 14 – 18 May 2012.

Draft definition of Nutrient Reference Values (for Inclusion in the Guidelines on Nutrition Labelling (CAC/GL 2-1985)) (REP 11/FL Appendix IV)

"Nutrient Reference Values (NRVs) are a set of numerical values that are based on scientific data and established for purposes of nutrition labelling and relevant claims. NRVs are based on levels of nutritents associated with nutrient requirements, or with the reduction in the risk of diet-related non-communicable diseases."
