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## BACKGROUND

1. The 26<sup>th</sup> Session of the Codex Committee on Processed Fruits and Vegetables (October 2012) agreed to advance the proposed draft Codex Standard for Certain Canned Fruits (general provisions applying to all canned fruits and specific provisions for canned mangoes)<sup>2</sup> and the proposed draft Codex Standard for Quick Frozen Vegetables (general provisions applying across these products)<sup>3</sup> to the 36<sup>th</sup> Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission (July 2013) for adoption at Step 5. The Commission adopted these texts as proposed by the Committee and advanced them for comments at Step 6<sup>4</sup>.

## REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

2. Codex Members and Observers are invited to submit comments on the draft Codex Standards for Certain Canned Fruits<sup>5</sup> and Quick Frozen Vegetables<sup>6</sup> in light of the discussion and decisions taken at the 26<sup>th</sup> Session of the Committee. In making comments, special attention should be attached to those sections in square brackets in particular the use of colours<sup>7</sup> in canned mangoes and submit technological justification following the guidance provided in the Procedural Manual of the Codex Alimentarius Commission<sup>8</sup> while considering the relevant provisions of the *General Standard for Food Additives* (CODEX STAN 192-1995) (food category 04.1.2.4 Canned or bottled (pasteurized) fruit) when available and appropriate.

3. Comments provided on methods of analysis will be forwarded to the electronic Working Group on Methods of Analysis<sup>9</sup> established by the Committee with a view to make proposals for consideration by the 27<sup>th</sup> Session of the CCPFV for incorporation in the relevant sections of these standards.
