

## **Background**

- 1. The 43<sup>rd</sup> Session of the Codex Committee on Food Labelling (CCFL43) noted that there was a need to investigate future direction and work for CCFL and agreed that Canada would prepare a paper summarizing some of the previously identified work that had not gone forward in the Committee; the currently ongoing work; and emerging issues.
- 2. CCFL43 further agreed that a Circular Letter would be issued requesting member countries and observers to provide information on emerging issues for inclusion in the aforementioned paper. (REP16/FL, para 71).
