BACKGROUND

- 1. CCFA50¹ considered the proposal by the Codex Secretariat for editorial amendments to the descriptors of FCs 14.1.4.2 and 14.1.5 of the GSFA in order to clarify under which FC the ready-to-drink coffee or tea beverages belong.
- 2. The Committee noted the need to clarify the appropriate Food Categories for ready-to-drink coffee and tea beverages and also noted the views that the proposed amendments to FCs 14.1.4.2 and 14.1.5: (i) might impact the food additives permitted in the products, meaning further work should be undertaken; (ii) were consistent with the previous responses provided by the Codex Secretariat; and (iii) reflected disagreement as to whether the proposal would limit or expand the use of the food additives permitted.
- 3. The Committee agreed to seek comments on the proposed amendments via circular letter and to consider the matter at CCFA51.

- 4. Codex members and observers are invited to submit comments, through the Codex Contact Points, on the proposed amendments to the descriptors of FCs 14.1.4.2 and 14.1.5.
