- SUBJECT: Request for comments on the recommendations for the establishment of maximum levels for cadmium and lead in quinoa

BACKGROUND

1. For background information, please refer to document CX/CF 24/17/13¹.

REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

- 2. Codex members and observers are invited to submit comments on the recommendations as described in paragraph 29 of CX/CF 24/17/13 which are described below for convenience:
- 2.1 to consider whether there is enough evidence indicating there is no need to establish MLs for lead and cadmium in quinoa; <u>or</u>
- 2.2 to consider whether there is enough evidence to establish MLs for lead and cadmium in quinoa, and if so, to either:
- 2.2.1 extend the MLs for cadmium and lead in cereal grains to quinoa; or
- 2.2.2 establish separate MLs for cadmium and lead in quinoa, and if in the affirmative, which MLs proposed by the JECFA Secretariat would be most appropriate as follows:
 - 1. <u>Proposed MLs for cadmium</u>: 0.1 or 0.2 mg/kg with rejection rates of approximately 5% and 0.2% respectively.
 - 2. <u>Proposed MLs for lead</u>: 0.1 or 0.2 mg/kg with rejection rates of approximately 4% and 0.4% respectively.
 - 3. Other alternative MLs that protect consumer's health and ensure fair practices in international trade based on the data/information presented in CX/CF 24/17/13 or additional data/information (in this case please provide reference to such data/information) or
- 2.3 to consider whether further investigation of the evidence for (2.2.1) the extension of the current MLs for cadmium and lead in cereal grains to include quinoa or (2.2.2) the establishment of separate MLs for cadmium and lead in quinoa is required <u>or</u>
- 2.4 to propose any other approach not considered under points 2.1 2.3 if available.
- 3. Codex members and observers are encouraged to submit comments in reply to this CL² in order to aid discussion and decision making at CCCF17.

- 4. Comments should be submitted through the Codex Contact Points of Codex members and observers using the OCS.
- 5. Contact Points of Codex members and observers may login to the OCS and access the document open for comments by selecting "Enter" in the "My reviews" page, available after login to the system.

Contact Points of Codex members and observers' organizations are requested to provide proposed changes and relevant comments/justifications on a specific paragraph (under the categories: editorial, substantive, technical and translation) and/or at the document level (general comments or summary comments).
