Notes on the Provisional Agenda

Agenda Item 3a: Draft Working Principles for Risk Analysis for Application in the Framework of the Codex Alimentarius

The 17th Session of the Committee advanced the *Proposed Draft Working Principles for Risk Analysis for Application in the Framework of the Codex Alimentarius* to Step 5. Agenda Item 3b: Proposed Working Principles for Risk Analysis for Food Safety
