



# **OVERVIEW OF CCSCH7**

The 7<sup>th</sup> Session of the Committee on Spices and Culinary Herbs will be held in Kochi, Kerala, India during 29<sup>th</sup> January to 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2024. The Sessions will take place at Hotel Le Meridien Kochi, Kerala, India. The Sessions will be conducted in English, French, Spanish and Arabic with simultaneous interpretation. The plenary sessions will be streamed live online.

The opening session will begin at 09:30 hours Indian Standard Time (IST) on Monday, 29th January 2024. Sessions will take place on 29, 30, and 31 January 2024 from 09:30 to 17:00 hours IST.

The draft report of the sessions will be made available in English, French and Spanish. The adoption of the Report will take place on Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2024 from 09.30 hours IST.

# (b) VENUE CITY: KOCHI (COCHIN), KERALA, INDIA ACCESSIBILITY BY AIR

A number of domestic and international flights operate from the Cochin International Airport (COK) located at Nedumbassery, connecting the city with major cities in India, and across the globe.

#### **ACCESSIBILITY BY RAIL**

Trains running from the main railway stations in Kochi, *viz*. Ernakulam Junction (South), and Ernakulam Town (North), connect to all major cities of India. For travel within the main part of the city, the elevated Metro trains may be explored.

#### **ACCESSIBILITY BY ROAD**

An extensive network of National/ State highways and local roads link Kochi to the rest of the country. Private and public transport services are also available from all major cities of India.



## **GETTING TO THE VENUE**

The Le Meridien Kochi is the venue hotel where the entire session of CCSCH7 will be held. It is located at Maradu, Ernakulam, Kochi (Cochin) which is approximately 32 Kms away from the Cochin International Airport (Nedumbassery Airport). Prepaid taxis are available at both the national and international terminals. Uber and Ola services are also available. Alternatively, hotels can be requested to provide taxis on payment.

Preferential rates for rooms will be available for the CCSCH7 delegates during the session period, from 28th January 2024 onwards, at the venue hotel. Please note that the availability of accommodation at the venue hotel is limited.

# GENERALINFORMATION (a) LOCAL CURRENCY

India's official currency is the Indian Rupee. Currency exchange facilities are available with major banks, at the airport and with the authorized dealers in the city. ATMs are available at the Airport as well as near the venue hotel. International credit cum debit cards are accepted in most shops.

## (b) ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

India uses 230 volts, 50 Hz alternating current as the power source. The two pin plug is also called the Europlug. It has two round 4 mm (0.157 in) pins. The three pin plug is rated at 6A / 250V. It has three round pins in a triangular pattern

# (c) LANGUAGE

People generally speak English, Hindi and Malayalam.

## (d) WEATHER

During January -February, Kochi has usually sunny days and nights. The temperature varies between 25 to 33°C.

## (e) TIME ZONE

Kochi is in the Indian Standard time zone (IST). GMT + 5.30 hours. There is no daylight saving.

PLACES OF INTERESTS IN AND AROUND KOCHL

Kerala is regarded as a tourists paradise and offers many places of enchanting and engaging beauty. The city of Kochi (cochin) has a rich history and has a plenty of sites that attract global visitors. Some of the nearby attractions are Fort Kochi beach with Chinese fishing nets, Hill Palace museum, Santa Cruz Cathedral Basilica, and the Marine Drive.

Historical sites: Mattancherry/ Fort Kochi - Jew Town, Jewish Synagogue, St. Francis Church, Santa Cruz Basilica, Vasco House, Dutch Palace, Fort Kochi beach, Chinese fishing nets. Also to watch the sunset. or a dance drama will be a great experience for an evening.

**Dance forms:** Classical dance form of Kerala, "Mohiniyattam", which literally means "Dance of the Enchantress", will be a visual treat. In addition, the classical dance-drama form of Kerala, Kathakali, which means a story play or a dance drama will be a great experience worth an evening.

**Cherai beach**: One can enjoy a swim or take a walk in the fishing villages, paddy fields and coconut groves and sip the juice of a tender coconut.









**Museums and art galleries:** Museum of Kerala History, Gallery of Contemporary Art, Hill Palace Museum and Chaithram Art Gallery.

**Shopping:** Broadway or Jew Town (Mattancherry) for curios, and handicrafts. Modern shopping malls like Forum, LULU, etc, sell exquisite traditional as well as designer products. For authentic sources of incredible Indian spices, one may explore the Spice India Signature Stall at the Lulu Mall, Edapally. There are plenty of stalls selling spices and artifacts in Fort kochi.

**Boat-rides:** One can enjoy a boat-ride along the scenic backwaters of Cochin. For extended period, a "Kettuvallom" (houseboat) may be hired to spend a few nights on board slowly travelling up the tranquil backwaters while having freshly cooked meals prepared with freshly caught fish. One can also enjoy the recently introduced 'Water Metro' boating services.
