NOTES ON THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Item 7(a) Draft and proposed draft revision of the Classification of Food and Feed at Steps 7 and 4: Vegetable Commodity Groups

The document compiles all the vegetable commodity groups finalized by the Committee since the beginning of work on the revision of the Classification of Food and Feed in addition to editorial revisions as entrusted by CCPR48 (2016) to the EWG on the revision of the Classification. In addition, the document examines the impact of the revised vegetable commodity groups (as finalized by CCPR) on the existing CXLs for such groups (as adopted by CAC).

The document is not for comment and should be read in conjunction with the document for Agenda item 7(e) in relation to proposals for representative commodities for the vegetable commodity groups (Table 2).

Item 7(e) Proposed draft Tables - Examples of selection of representative commodities (vegetable and other commodity groups) (for inclusion in the *Principles and guidance for the selection of representative commodities for the extrapolation of maximum residue limits for pesticides to commodity groups*) at Step 4

Table 2 in this document should be read in conjunction with the document under Agenda Item 7(a).

Note 1: It should be kept in mind that both the revised classification on vegetable commodity groups (7a) and the representative commodities for vegetable commodity groups (7e) should be finalised and submitted for adoption by CAC simultaneously.

Note 2: It should be kept in mind that any comments submitted on commodity groups under Agenda Items 7(b) to 7(d) should be done in conjunction with comments on Agenda Item 7(e) for the related representative commodities as the Classification and the selection of representative commodities for the extrapolation of MRLs for pesticides are closely interrelated.

Item 10(a) Establishment of Codex Priority List of Pesticides

The elaboration of the Priority List corresponds to Step 1 of the Codex MRLs Elaboration Procedure. The Committee will consider a document prepared by the Chair of the Working Group on Priorities (presented as a conference room document) based on CX/PR 17/49/13 which contains collated proposals for priority lists of pesticides based on comments submitted in reply to CL 2017/12-PR.

Item 10(b) Information on national registrations of pesticides Establishment of a Codex database on national registrations of pesticides

The Committee will consider document CX/PR 16/49/14 prepared by Australia and Germany in reply to CL 2017/18-PR following information submitted by Codex members on their registration of pesticides. This document should be read in conjunction with the proposal to establish a database on national registrations of pesticides (CX/PR 16/49/15).
