#### Recommendation No. 22 a

Comment: We recommend for full references to be maintained in the text

Rationale: This will make it more convenient when reading and using the document to prevent having to go

back and forth to a separate document.

#### Recommendation No. 22 b

**Comment:** Ghana suggests that the proposed draft is advanced to the next step of the Codex process Ghana supports "Option B" unders Recommendations; for the Committee to consider the development of new work to merge and rewrite the new and existing equivalence guidance.

Rationale: Option B removes the of referring to two different documents on equivalence.

#### **Section 3 Definitions**

Comment: Ghana suggests that the text in square brackets be left as is

Rationale: This is because it removes ambiguity

#### **Section 4 Principles**

Comment: The phrase "likely to" is preferred by Ghana as opposed to the use of the word "will"

Rationale: The choice offers flexibility in achieving equivalence and gives room for developing countries to

achieve progressively high levels of quality assurance.

Point f

Comment: Ghana suggests the retention of the phrase "and timely" in the text.

Rationale: Because it is important for trade facilitation

#### **Scope and Consideration**

**Comment:** Ghana suggests the examples in point 16 are retained in the document.

Rationale: The examples make the text more specific

#### **NFCS Objectives**

Comment: Ghana suggest to retain "periodic review and continuous improvement"

Rationale: Because it provides more emphasis.
