ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

- Item 1 Adoption of the Agenda** (Doc. Ref.: CX/EURO 07/25/1). In accordance with Rule VII.2 of the Rules of Procedure, the first item on the Provisional Agenda shall be the adoption of the Agenda.
- Item 2 Matters Arising from the Codex Alimentarius Commission and other Codex Committees** (Doc. Ref.: CX/EURO 07/25/2). This item includes matters related to the Region arising from recent sessions of the Commission and other Codex Committees and Task Forces.
- Item 3 Activities of FAO and WHO Complementary to the Work of the Codex Alimentarius Commission, Including Capacity Building** (Doc. Ref.: CX/EURO 07/25/3). The Representatives of FAO and WHO will provide a report on the activities of FAO and WHO complementary to the work of Codex Alimentarius Commission and on the capacity building programmes for countries in transition.
- Item 4 Information on National Food Control Systems and Consumer Participation in Food Standard Setting** (Doc. Ref.: CX/EURO 07/25/4). The 57th Session of the Executive Committee agreed to combine all issues related to food legislation, food control, national Codex structures and consumer participation, which had been discussed under two different agenda items, into one single item in order to facilitate reporting by member countries and to rationalize discussion in the Coordinating Committees, taking into account possible duplication and confusion in the consideration of these items (ALINORM 06/29/3, para 103). Informations submitted in response to CL 2006/21-EURO, Part A, are contained in CX/EURO 07/25/4.
- Item 5 Information on Use of Codex Standards at National and Regional Level** (Doc. Ref.: CX/EURO 07/25/6). The 57th Session of the Executive Committee agreed to add a new agenda item to regional coordinating committees regarding the use of Codex standards and related texts at the national and regional levels. In pursuit to this decision, it has recommended that members of the Coordinating Committee submit information on the use of Codex standards (ALINORM 06/29/3, paras 104-105). Informations submitted in response to CL 2006/21-EURO, Part B, are contained in CX/EURO 07/25/5.
- Item 6 Nomination of the Coordinator** (Doc. Ref.: CX/EURO 07/25/6). In accordance with Rule IV.2 of the Rules of Procedure of the Codex Alimentarius Commission, the Committee is invited to nominate a Coordinator for Europe for appointment by the 30th Session of the Commission.
- Item 7 Other Business, Future Work.** In accordance Rule VII.5 of the Rules of Procedure, any Member of the Commission may propose the inclusion of specific items of an urgent matter. However, it is strongly recommended to submit the item, if any, in a written form well in advance of the session.
- Item 8 Date and Place of the Next Session:** The Committee will be advised of the tentative dates of the next session.
- Item 9 Adoption of the Report.** In accordance with Rule X.1 of the Commission's Rules of Procedure, the Committee shall adopt the report of its 25th Session, based on a draft provided by the Secretariat.
