Committee on Food Additives (CCFA48)

REVISION OF SECTION 4.2.3.4 OF THE GENERAL STANDARD FOR THE LABELLING OF PREPACKAGED FOODS (CODEX STAN 1-1985)

Background

1. CCFA47 supported new work to address the inconsistent terminology related to flavourings; and agreed to limit the scope of the new work to the revision of sections 4.1c and 5.1c of the *General Standard for the Labelling of Food Additives When Sold As such* (CODEX STAN 107-1981) so that these provisions are consistent with the *Guidelines for the Use of Flavourings* (CAC/GL 66-2008).

2. CCFA47 also agreed to first complete work on CODEX STAN 107-1981 before other committees could be informed to consider revising texts under their responsibility (or before CCFA would consider revising texts developed by inactive committees).¹

Request from CCFA

3. CCFA48 completed the revisions of sections 4.1c and 5.1c of CODEX STAN 107-1981 and agreed to recommend to CCFL to consider the revision of section 4.2.3.4 of the *General Standard for the Labelling of Prepackaged Foods* (CODEX STAN 1-1985) taking into account the revision of sections 4.1c and 5.1c of CODEX STAN 107-1981.

4. CCFL43 agreed to consider the recommendation by CCFA to revise section 4.2.3.4 of CODEX STAN 1-1985 at a future date after examining the likely impact of the proposed changes.²

5. The Committee **is invited to consider** how to proceed with this request.
