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ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Item 1 Adoption of the agenda (Doc. Ref.: CX/NASWP 10/11/1). In accordance with Rule VII.2 of the Rules of Procedure, the first item on the provisional agenda shall be the adoption of the agenda.

- Item 2 Matters arising from the Codex Alimentarius Commission and other Codex committees (Doc. Ref.: CX/NASWP 10/11/2). This item includes matters related to the region arising from recent sessions of the Commission and other Codex committees and task forces.
- Item 3(a) Activities of FAO and WHO complementary to the work of the Codex Alimentarius Commission (Doc. Ref.: CX/NASWP 10/11/3). The Representatives of FAO and WHO will report on their activities complementary to the work of Codex Alimentarius Commission.
- **Item 3(b)** Outcomes of Codex Trust Fund mid term review (Doc. Ref.: CX/NASWP 10/11/3). The Representatives of FAO and WHO will report on the outcomes of the Codex Trust Fund mid term review.
- **Item 3(c)** Activities of other international / regional organizations (Doc. Ref.: CX/NASWP 10/11/5). The Observers of other international / regional organizations will report on their activities relevant to the activities of CCNASWP.
- Item 4 Strategic plan for CCNASWP 2008-2013
- **Item 4(a) Status of implementation of the Strategic plan for the CCNASWP 2008-2013** (Doc. Ref.: CX/NASWP 10/11/6). The 10th CCNASWP agreed to request the Coordinator to monitor the implementation of the Strategic plan and to present a report on the status of implementation at the 11th Session of CCNASWP (ALINORM 09/32/32, para, 36).
- Item 4(b) Comments and Information on national food control systems, consumer participation in food standards setting and the use of Codex standards at the national level (replies to CL 2009/28-NASWP) (Doc. Ref.: CX/NASWP 10/11/7). The 10th CCNASWP agreed that a Circular letter be issued in the form of a questionnaire which would link more directly the information on status of national food legislation, food control, Codex structure and consuemr participation to the objectives and activities if the Strategic Plan for CCNASWP 2008-2013. (ALINORM 09/32/32, para. 50). Document CX/NASWP 10/11/7 compiles comments and information submitted in response to CL 2009/28-NASWP.
- **Item 5 Discussion paper on kava** (Doc. Ref.: CX/NASWP 10/11/8). The 10th CCNASWP agreed that the Coordinator, in consultation with the Pacific Island Countries, would prepare a paper which should compile information on: (i) scope of kava products and evidence of the use of kava as food; (ii) processing methoids; (iii) regulaory measures for safety control of these products by countries; (iv) markets of exports; and other relevant issues for consideration at its next (ALINORM 09/32/32, para. 44).
- **Item 6 Nomination of the Coordinator** (Doc. Ref.: CX/NASWP 10/11/9). In accordance with Rule IV.2 of the Rules of Procedure of the Codex Alimentarius Commission, the Committee is invited to nominate a Coordinator for North America and South West Pacific for appointment by the 34th Session of the Commission.
- **Item 7 Other business and future work**. In accordance Rule VII.5 of the Rules of Procedure, any Member of the Commission may propose the inclusion of specific items of an urgent matter. However, it is strongly recommended to submit the item, if any, in a written form well in advance of the session.
