GROUND TRANSPORTATION

For the best value we recommend the LAX **FLYAWAY BUS** for transfer to the CCFH Venue Hotel.

No advance reservations are needed. The one-way fare for non-stop **service to Union Station is \$8.** Passengers board buses on the Lower/ Arrivals Level, curbside, in front of each terminal under the green "FlyAway®, Buses and Long Distance Vans" sign. Take the Fly Away Bus to Union Station, where you will depart and take a taxi to the hotel. From Union Station to the The L.A. Hotel Downtown is a 5-minute taxi ride.

SUPER SHUTTLE

This shared-ride service transports travelers to and from their private address, office or hotel. It takes longer than a taxi due to more frequent stops but may be more affordable, especially if travelling alone. Private limousines are also available. For fare quotes and reservations go to **SUPER SHUTTLE**, the shared van service to and from **LAX to the hotel is \$17 one-way**.

- The average high temperature still reaches 23°C (around 73°F) but can also drop as low as 10°C (about 50°F).

CURRENCY


- United States Dollar (\$).
