- Item 3 Matters Referred to the Committee by the Codex Alimentarius Commission and/or Other Codex Committees: The Committee will consider matters referred to it by the 29th Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission and Codex Committees that met since the 38th Session of the Committee. - Item 7 Matters Related to Methods of Analysis for Pesticide Residues: (to be considered by the *Ad Hoc* Working Group):
- (a) Discussion paper on the Application of Practices on the Estimation of Uncertainty of Results. The Committee at its last Session agreed to request information from governments on application of practices currently in use at the national or regional level on measurement uncertainty in reporting test results and its application in relation to the risk management of pesticide residues in food. The discussion paper would be prepared by the International Atomic Agency (document CX/PR 07/39/5).
- (b) **Proposed Draft Revision of the List of Methods for Pesticide Residue Analysis at Step 4.** The Committee is invited to discuss the above proposed draft revision of the List of Methods for Pesticide Residue Analysis (document CX/PR 07/39/6) to be prepared by International Atomic Agency. Government comments would be presented in CX/PR 07/39/6-Add.1.
- (c) **Discussion Paper on Methods of Analysis for Fat-Soluble Pesticides in Whole Milk and Milk Fat.** The Committee at its last Session agreed to ask information on the current analytical practices concerning the separation of whole milk and milk fat and the methodology for the determination of fat soluble pesticides in milk and milk products. The paper to be prepared by the International Atomic Agency (document CX/PR 07/39/7.
- Item 8 **Establishment of MRLs for Processed and Ready-to-Eat Foods.** At the request of the last session of the Committee, the paper will be prepared by the European Community (document CX/PR 07/39/8).
- Item 9. **Establishment of Codex Priority Lists of Pesticides:** The elaboration of the priority list corresponds to Step 1 of the Codex MRLs Elaboration Procedure. The Committee will consider a paper CX/PR 07/39/9 to be prepared by Australia based on proposals received in response to CL 2006/9-PR. The outcome of the Working Group would be presented in CRD 1 to be prepared by Australia.
- Item 10 **Discussion Paper about Enforcement of Codex MRLs.** At the last Session the Committee agreed that a paper on this matter to be prepared by the Netherlands (document CX/PR 07/39/10.
- Item 11. **Other Business and Future Work:** In accordance with Rule V.5 of the Rules of Procedure, any Member of the Commission after dispatch of the Provisional Agenda may propose the inclusion of specific items in the Agenda with respect to matters of an urgent nature. The Committee may propose to undertake new work, which shall be in compliance with the Medium Term Plan and subject to the approval by the Commission.
