Comments on Agenda Item 3: Matters referred to the Committee by the Codex Alimentarius Commission and/or other subsidiary bodies, submitted by Kenya and African Union

Kenya

Issue: Work Management -The Executive Committee requested all Committees to consider the need to develop an approach for the management of their work similar to that used by the Committee on Food Hygiene (while recognizing the differences in topics, working procedures, etc. among various committees).

Position: we support the approach of management of CCPR work similar to that of CCFH alongside the codex schedule and priority lists of pesticides 2017-2021 (agenda 10).

African Union

Position:

AU welcomes the matter referred to this committee by the 38th Session of the Codex Alimentarius. We agree with the recommendation of the executive committee (Rep 15/EXEC, para 22) to all the committee on developing approaches for the management of their work.

Issues/Justification:
