

INTERNATIONAL NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS IN OBSERVER STATUS WITH THE CODEX ALIMENTARIUS COMMISSION

(Report by the Secretariat)

- 1. The Principles Concerning the Participation of International Nongovernmental Organizations in the Work of the Codex Alimentarius Commission require the Secretariat to "report to the Codex Alimentarius Commission on the relations between the Codex Alimentarius Commission and international non-governmental organizations established in accordance with the present Procedures and shall provide a list of organizations granted Observer Status, with an indication of the membership that they represent".
- 2. The report of the Secretariat is attached in the following form:
 - A list of international non-governmental organizations currently in "Observer Status" with the Codex Alimentarius Commission (Annex 1); and
 - A list of international non-governmental organizations whose status has been changed or is pending (new applications, terminations) (Annex 2).
- 3. This report reflects the status as of 15 May 2008 and is submitted to the Commission for information. The Commission is also invited to note that the observer status of international non-governmental organizations is being reviewed at the 61st Session of the Executive Committee (CX/EXEC 08/61/7).
