3. TRANSPORTATION BETWEEN THE AIRPORT AND HOTEL

Please be informed that no shuttle service from the airport will be provided by CFS. However, all major hotels operate regular shuttle services to and from the airport. Check directly with your hotel for details.

4. CURRENCY AND FOREIGN EXCHANGE SERVICES

The monetary unit of Ethiopia's currency is the birr. The current exchange rate is approximately: USD 1 to ETB 19. All major credit cards are readily accepted in Ethiopia. Exchange facilities and an ATM are available at the Airport in Ethiopia.

5. CLIMATE

Addis Ababa stays quite cool throughout the year with daily average high temperatures rarely over 20 degrees Celsius.

6. ELECTRICITY

Ethiopia uses round two/three pin plugs, as used in most of Europe.
