

INVITATIONS TO AFCAS MEMBER COUNTRIES

Review of CPC 2.1 & CPC expanded for agricultural statistics



- Collaboration between FAO & UNSD to improve CPC for AG statistics since 2005
- Next CPC version (2.1) available in 2014 incl. review of AG&FI&FO items
- In addition, CPC 2.1 expanded for AG adds detail at the lower level of standard CPC (5digits) with supplementary codes on crops, livestock & derived products



- CPC 2.1 expanded will replace FAOSTAT commodity list → no loss of information
- Currently under testing in the statistical working system

Strengths of CPC compared to FCL



- Structure, definitions and codes are improved
- Possibility for countries to expand the structure to include local products/varieties at lower level
- Better harmonization with HS 2012
- High level of detail and meaningful aggregates for statistics and economic analysis
- Facilitate integration of agriculture into national statistical systems
- Review every 5 years by way of a international participative process where countries are fully involved

Review of HS 2012 and 2017




- HS 2012 (into force in 01/12): >300 new AG&FI items: more suitable for AG&FI statistics, establishes solid correspondences with CPC
- HS 2017 (into force in 01/17): FAO submitted a number of proposals to WCO incl. AG&FI&FO products, fertilizers & machinery
 - consultations within and outside FAO conducted to verify the extent to which HS12 detail was sufficient for the FAO
 - items selected according to global trade value, no. of countries involved, monitoring of food security, endangered species or stocks in need, and conservation agriculture practices
 - proposals were discussed at the HS Review Sub-Committee/ 43/44/45/46 sessions and HS Committee/42 session
 - most of the FAO proposals are approved

Survey on National Classifications for Agriculture and Food Products (2012/13)



To assess:

- what product classifications used by countries for AG & food products
- extent to which international standards are implemented (focus on CPC)
- needs on technical assistance and capacity development



Database on Commodity Classifications



- facilitate countries and other users in their search in the FAOSTAT commodity list definitions & correspondences to CPC and HS
- available in EN
- FR and SP translations underway

Guidelines on Classifications for Agricultural Statistics




- development planned for 2014 under the Global

- will provide a useful aid to countries planning to adopt and adapt international classifications for agricultural statistics to their statistical system


Questions & Recommendations for Discussion



- Encourage member countries to adopt CPC, and other international standard classifications. FAO is committed to provide assistance to this process
 - discuss opportunities, challenges and potential solutions
- Ask for endorsement of the progress made by FAO in integrating agriculture, fishery and forestry into major international product classifications
- Seek advice and collaboration from member countries on the development of future work and support the role of the RAF in this area of work
- Recommend member countries complete the FAO Survey on National Classifications for Agriculture and Food Products
- Affirm the need to strengthen partnerships on statistical classifications with Regional Organizations in Africa and member countries in the near future
