IdCA focuses on



- Existing infrastructure to produce agriculture statistics
- Minimum set of core data item
- Evaluation of existing system of AS
- Find out critical constraints in AS system
- SOWT Analysis
- Address special issues





- Assigning two focal officers
 - one for IdCA of Agriculture Statistics (workshop held on 7 December 2013)
- another for Regional Project on Building Statistical Capacity for Quality Food Security and Nutrition Information in Support of Better informed Policy (workshop held on 13 February 2014)

- National Consultant for IdCA recruited by FAO
- Working Group including members from eleven ministries/agencies formed (two meetings conducted)
- Focal Point Officers appointed from twelve ministries/agencies)





 Filling up of the IdcA Questionnaire has been completed

(assessment on filled in Questionnaire is going on, most of the data are available)

 Assessment Report will be finalised by NC by May 2014 under the guidance of FAO and with the active involvement of Focal Point Officers



Advantages to implement IdCA as well as GS



- Agriculture Statistics has been integrated to National Statistical System since 1974
- NSDS has been approved by the Cabinet where proper focus is given in the areas of agriculture statistics
- Statistics Act has enabled BBS to conduct Agriculture Census for broader sector like crop, livestock, fisheries and forestry
- FAO is actively playing catalytic role among BBS, USDA and BMGF to improve Agriculture Statistics in Bangladesh

- 2. Assessment of core list of Indicators for Agricultural and Rural statistics (most are available)
- 3. Integration of Agriculture and Rural statistics into National Statistical System (Integrated since 1974)
- 4. Application of Remote Sensing Technology in producing agriculture statistics (Area used for two major rice)
