

# FAO Hunger Map 2013

Progress in reducing hunger is assessed against two key targets: the 1996 World Food Summit (WFS) target aims at halving the **number** of undernourished by 2015, while the first Millennium Development Goal (MDG) aims at halving the **proportion** of hungry people by 2015.

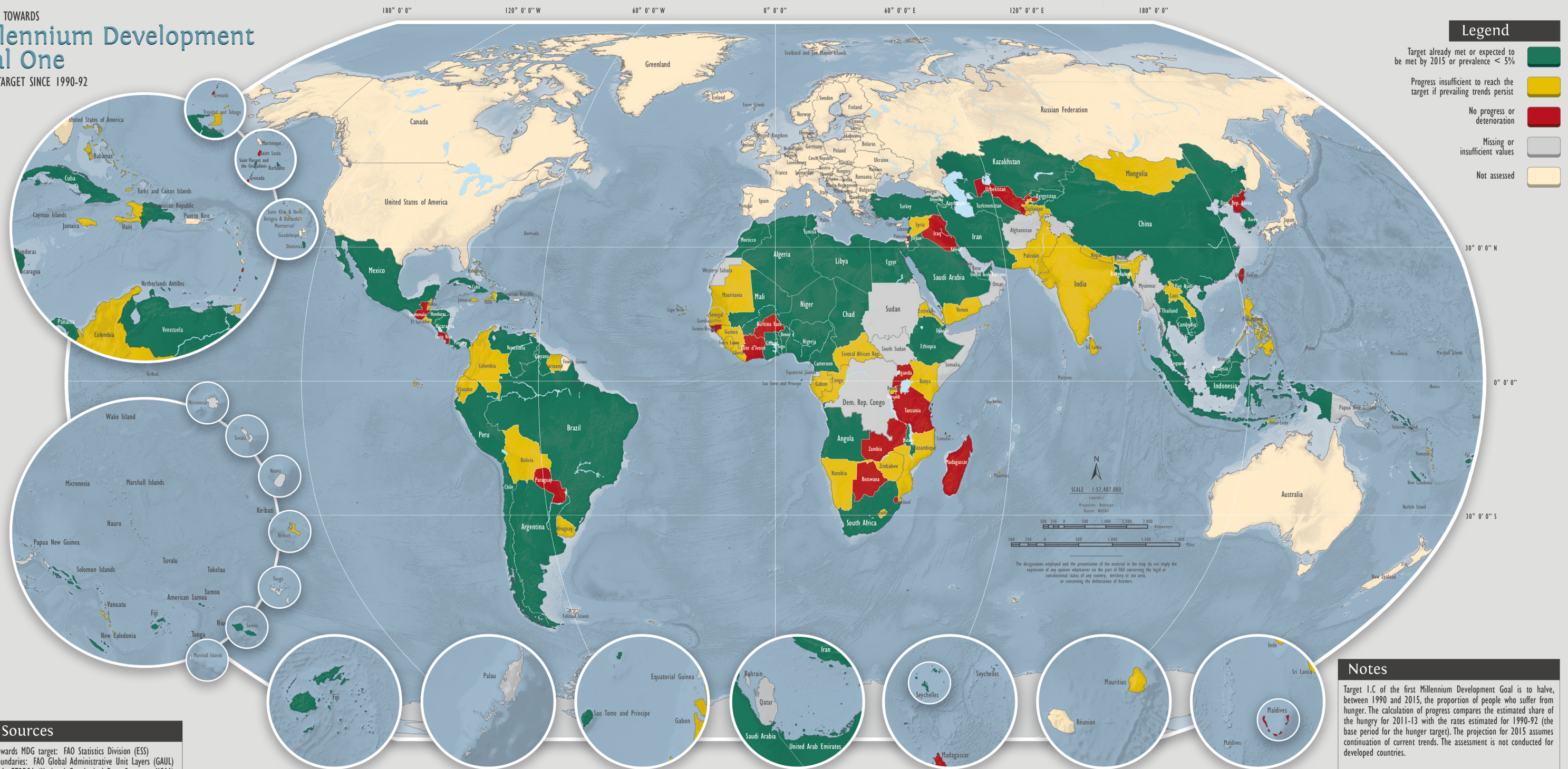

Progress towards MDG target: FAO Statistics Division (ESS)  
Political boundaries: FAO Global Administrative Unit Layers (GAUL)  
Global relief: ETOPO1 (National Geophysical Data Center – NOAA)  
Inland water bodies: FAO Land and Water Division (NRL)

## Notes

Target 1.C of the first Millennium Development Goal is to halve, between 1990 and 2015, the proportion of people who suffer from hunger. The calculation of progress compares the estimated share of the hungry for 2011-13 with the rates estimated for 1990-92 (the base period for the hunger target). The projection for 2015 assumes continuation of current trends. The assessment is not conducted for developed countries.

South Sudan declared its independence on 9 July 2011. Data for Sudan (post-2011) and South Sudan are not yet available.
