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



Monitoring progress towards hunger reduction targets of the World Food Summit (WFS) and the Millennium Development Goals (MDG)

Zimbabwe had a high level of undernourishment in 2006-08, the latest period available; 30 percent of the total population was undernourished. Both the number and proportion of undernourished increased from 1990-92, benchmark period of the WFS and MDG, to 2000-02 but decreased from 2000-02 to 2006-08.
