



HOW TO DERIVE FOOD SECURITY AND NUTRITION STATISTICS FROM NATIONAL HOUSEHOLD SURVEYS?

ADePT-Food Security Module



The FAO Statistics Division has developed, in close collaboration with the World Bank's Poverty Team, Development Research Group, the **free stand-alone software ADePT-Food Security Module (FSM)**.

ADePT-FSM aims at improving the quality, consistency and availability of food security and nutrition statistics derived from National Household Surveys (NHS), such as Living Standard Measurement Surveys (LSMS), Household Income and Expenditure (HIES) and Household Budget Surveys (HBS) collecting food consumption data in both quantity and monetary values.

These food and nutrition statistics are useful for assessing and monitoring food security at national and subnational levels.

FAO Statistics Division has developed guidelines for the use of the ADePT- Food Security Module for deriving a suite of food security and nutrition statistics.
