The Global Strategy is a comprehensive framework for improving the availability and use of agricultural and rural data, necessary for evidence-based decision making.

The strategy is being implemented in up to 90 developing countries in Africa, Asia and the Pacific, Latin America and the Caribbean, Near East and the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS).

how?

- In-depth country assessments help identify the appropriate short-term interventions required by each country and develop long-term statistical sector strategies.
- Cost-effective methods are implemented in countries as a result of a specific research programme.
- 3 Countries are provided with technical assistance and guidance to create the appropriate framework for developing sustainable agricultural and rural statistical systems.
- Country experts are provided with training and statistical training centres' capacities are upgraded.
