The Legal Office provided technical legal advice on the drafting of the Voluntary Guidelines for the Progressive Realization of the Right to Adequate Food in the Context of National Food Security (Right to Food Guidelines), which were adopted by the Council in 2004 and their subsequent implementation at the national level.

A groundbreaking instrument for food security governance, the Right to Food Guidelines recommend the strengthening of constitutional and legal frameworks for the realization of the right to food, including through framework law approaches.
