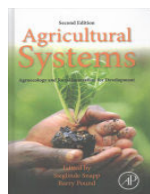

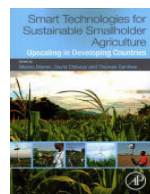

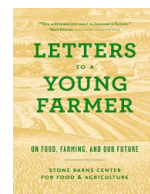

Encyclopédie: innovation in the 18th century

The *Encyclopédie* is considered one of the masterpieces of the age of Enlightenment as it reflects the most important intellectual and social developments of its time. Its aim was to open up knowledge in the Sciences, Arts and Crafts. In total it comprised seventeen folio volumes containing 71,818 entries of which many on agriculture, fisheries and forestry - making the latest innovations in these fields accessible to a wide audience.
