FAO staff can access WoS, the world's largest abstract and citation platform of leading peer-reviewed international and regional scientific literature. For any questions see <http://www.fao.org/library/resources/fao-library-resources/web-of-science-package/en/>.

FAO employees in the field will have to access the WoS the first time through the FAO Secure Access Gateway and create a WoS account. Once you have a WoS account, you are able to enter the platform from any non-FAO computer (for 6 months) by logging in with your credentials.
