### **Annex 1      Terms of Reference of the RPSC (as amended at 1<sup>st</sup> meeting of the RPSC on 18 March 2011)**

The Kagera TAMP RPSC will be responsible for the following specific tasks, *inter alia*:

1. Ensure that transboundary issues identified for consideration by Kagera TAMP are adequately addressed by the project and that policy decisions are taken into consideration
2. Facilitate coordination among Kagera TAMP, LVEMP and NBI-NELSAP and other regional programmes and organisations for effective collaboration and cofounding among the programmes including through the development and implementation of MOUs
3. Review and approve annual project work plans and budget and provide guidance for the overall project;
4. RPSC will be informed electronically of TORs for international project posts, contracts and consultants for comments and suggestions by members as appropriate;
5. Assess progress in the implementation of the project and recommend necessary actions and measures to be taken towards smooth achievement of the project objectives;
6. Consider recommendations of the National project steering committee and regional Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and propose appropriate guidance.
7. Review and guide on criteria for selection of target transboundary interventions and ensure that the intervention areas in each country will enable to achieve the overall project objectives and in guiding the scaling up process from selected catchments and land units for wider adoption across the basin.
8. Review and guide on mechanisms for basin-wide networking, database and website development;
9. Approve TAMP basin-wide communication and dissemination mechanisms and partnerships;
10. Monitor inputs of international and national partners, ensuring that project obligations are fulfilled in a timely and coordinated fashion;
11. Provide guidance to the NPMs and the TAMP Regional project Coordinator on management and implementation issues to ensure the project achieves its goals and ensure cost effectiveness and sustainability.
12. Hold teleconferences if there are important issues that need to be discussed among the 4 countries
