#### Conclusions

- Percentage of Male header is higher in Moutanining and Highlands areas comparing to areas
- At Ha Noi province, fewer (8 percentage points) female header HHs have access to annual land (paddy land) compared to Male.
- At country level, Female header have accessed loans/credit more than male.
